MOTION FOR CONSOLIDATION OF CASES

Comes now the Appellant, *pro se* and prepared with the assistance of counsel, pursuant to the Fla. R. Jud. Admin. 2.210 (a)(2) to move this court, in the interest of judicial and legal economy, to request the consolidation of case number 4D09-10 with case number 4D09-1386, “for all purposes” as follows:

1. Case number 4D09-1386 is an appeal from a final Court Order Denying Former Husband’s Supplemental Petition for Modification of Alimony and Motion to Vacate Alimony Arrearages (D.E. 521) on the following motions and petition:
 - a. Appellant’s Motion to Vacate Alimony Arrearages (D.E. 431) and Memorandum in Support of Motion to Vacate Alimony Arrearages (D.E. 433A)

b. Appellant's Petition for Modification of Alimony Requesting Support for Former Husband (D.E. 432), and Memorandum of Law in Support of Petition for Modification of Alimony Requesting Support for Former Husband (D.E. 512).

Consolidations of the cases is desirable as all of the proceedings are interrelated in the lower court under the same case number as are the reliefs sought. Central to the proceedings are the payments towards alimony arrearages, which comprise the core of the problem, giving rise to the contempt proceedings and motion to vacate arrearages.

Alimony arrearages are the contributing factor giving rise to Mr. Cabana's request for alimony to provide relief from the arrearages and for support resulting from a change of circumstances that now find him in "need" of support in order to remove him from the public welfare rolls.

WHEREFORE, Appellant, *pro se*, prays this court grant the consolidation of the above cases.
