**Questions To Be Answered By Former Wife As Part Of Form 12-930(c)**


1. Is the mortgage(s) on your residential properties the original(s) that were part of the original purchase or an equity loan taken out at a later date?
2. Do you have appraisals to justify the values claimed for all properties owned by you or in which you have an interest? If so, please provide name, address and phone number of appraiser and dates of appraisal. If not, how did you establish their value?
3. Can you provide paid receipts for repairs to the residential properties you own or control? List all repairs, date of repair, party performing repair with business addresses and phone numbers and dollar amount and item repaired.
4. Do you operate any activity or businesses in addition to your normal employment? List all business or income-generating activities with date began and annual revenues generated by the activities and income to you from them for the past three years.
5. Are you in need of the alimony for basic living expenses?
6. Have you remarried or do you have someone living with you, either on a temporary or permanent basis, who is not a member of your family?
7. What is your purpose in further court action against your former husband when you have been informed that he is unable to make permanent alimony payments and is living below the Federal poverty level?

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
