Disclosure**


COMES NOW the former husband WILLIAM A. CABANA, pro se, respectfully
objecting to Respondent's Motion for Enlargement of Time. In support he offers,

1. On March 19, 2004 Former Husband filed a Supplemental Petition for
Modification of Alimony.
2. On or about March 31, 2004, Former Husband served Standard Family Law
Interrogatories on Former Wife, which have gone unanswered. A second Standard
Family Law Interrogatories was served on Former Wife May 16, 2005 and is now due.
3. On June 1, 2005, at a hearing, this court ordered Former Husband to Compel
Production, Answers to Interrogatories and Financial Affidavit by June 10, 2005. The
time allotted was only nine days from the date of hearing to which he complied by June
9, 2005. Former Wife should not be granted preferential treatment in time to comply.

4. Former Wife has not shown cause to necessitate an enlargement of time per Fla. R.Civ.P. 1.090 and has had more than adequate time with which to produce the documents.

WHEREFORE former husband prays that this Honorable Court enter an order to deny Former Wife's Request for Enlargement of Time.
