SUPPLEMENTAL PETITION FOR MODIFICATION OF ALIMONY

I, William A. Cabana, being sworn, certify that the following information is true:

1. The parties to this action were granted a Final Judgment of Dissolution of Marriage on July 28, 1972. An Amended Final Judgment dated Oct. 21, 1986 amended the final judgment. There also exists an Income Deduction Order against Former Husband dated January 25, 1991. Copies of the Final Judgment, Amended Final Judgment and Income Deduction Orders are appended hereto.
2. The Final Judgment and Amended Final Judgment thereof establish the present alimony payable at a rate of \$25.00 every week. Also Child Support was awarded in the amount of \$50.00 every week.
3. There exist arrearages for alimony due in part to accrual of 12% interest charges on arrearages.
4. Since the final judgment or most recent modification thereof, there has been a substantial change in circumstances, requiring a modification in alimony. This change in circumstance is as follows:
 - a. Petitioner Former Husband is a Social Security recipient living on a low fixed income. Petitioner is 66, has health and physical problems and is not able to work full time.
 - b. Interest on support arrearages as required by the foregoing Court orders render it an impossibility for petitioner to pay this obligation from his present disposable income
 - c. Petitioner has no ability to pay Court ordered alimony due to decreased income.
 - d. Respondent/Former Wife has no need for receipt of alimony support payments.

5. These changed circumstances are permanent, significant, material and involuntary.
6. I ask the Court to modify alimony as follows:
 - a. Eliminate the requirement of future alimony payments.
 - b. Eliminate past due alimony and interest arrearages.
 - c. Require Respondent/Former Wife to pay alimony support to Petitioner/Former Husband in an amount determined equitable by the court.
 - d. Require that payment of all legal fees incurred by Respondent/Former Wife related to any and all, past and future alimony proceedings be her responsibility and not that of Petitioner/Former Husband.
7. A completed Family Law Financial Affidavit, Florida Family Law Rules of Procedure Form 12.902(b), is attached hereto and filed.


