**FORMER WIFE'S RESPONSE TO FORMER HUSBAND'S
EX-PARTE MOTION TO COMPEL DISCOVERY PURSUANT TO
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 5.011-9/92, SUBSECTION B**

COMES NOW the Former Wife, SHARON ANN MAYO, by and through her undersigned attorneys and responds to Former Husband's Ex-parte Motion to Compel Discovery Pursuant to Administrative Order No. 5.011-9/92, Subsection B, as follows:

1. On July 8, 2005, Former Wife filed her Response to Former Husband's Request to Produce bearing certificate of service dated June 13, 2005. On July 15, 2005 Former Wife filed her Supplemental Response to Former Husband's Request to Produce and on July 26, 2005 Former Wife filed her Second Supplemental Response.
2. On September 6, 2005 Former Wife filed her Response to Former Husband's Request to Produce bearing certificate of service dated August 5, 2005.
3. On September 19, 2005 Former Wife filed her Response to Former Husband's Request to Produce bearing certificate of service dated August 20, 2005.
4. Since Former Wife has properly filed her responses to the Requests to Produce,

Former Husband's Ex-Parte Motion to Compel is improper.


5. The Former Wife has retained the services of the undersigned counsel and has agreed to pay those reasonably incurred attorney's fees, for which Former Husband should be held accountable.
